

Pro Gun Club Range Rules

1. All Shooters must check-in at the clubhouse prior to shooting.
2. Everyone on premise must sign a Pro Gun Club Liability release form and view the safety video before they are allowed go out on to the property.
3. When shooting on the pistol and/or rifle range all shooters must have eye and ear protection on at all times.
4. Everyone must treat every weapon as if it is loaded even if the gun is unloaded, it is still treated as a loaded gun.
5. Guns should **NEVER** be pointed at anything the shooter is not willing to shoot or destroy.
6. Shooters must keep their finger off the trigger until they are ready to shoot.
7. Shooters must know their target and what is beyond before they begin shooting.
8. If shooting steel on the pistol range, all shooters must be at least 10 yards away.
9. All ranges are shared ranges unless otherwise specified by management or range officer.
10. Everyone must check in with a range officer to be assigned a range. When checking in please let the range officers know what exactly you will be shooting.
11. Cease fires will be called amongst shooters or whenever a range officer calls one. When people are down range, shooters must back off the firing line and not handle any guns until everyone is back and the firing line is live again. When the firing line is cold, all guns must be unloaded with the slide or bolt locked to the rear.
12. Any brass left on ranges is the property of Pro Gun Club. Shooters are not allowed to pick up any brass other than their own.
13. When shooting on the Sporting Clay course, the path for carts is clockwise only.
14. When shooting at a station or stand, shooters must only load two shells at any given time.
15. No shot larger than a 7 may be used while shooting clays.
16. Only shoot at valid clay targets. Please do not shoot any wild life while on the property.
17. Please pick up any shotgun shells and place them in the trash after you are done shooting.
18. Shooters must verify all guns are unloaded prior to moving to a new station.
19. If there is a problem with the clay machines, please do not try to fix them yourself. Contact the clubhouse and someone will come out to fix it.
